

# Software Installation Windows.

You can also install software for the following platforms using this procedure:-

Windows 3.xx	use Win16
Windows 95	use Win95
Windows 98	use Win95
Windows NT	use Winnt
Windows 2000	use Winnt
Windows XP	use Winnt

## STEP 1

### Installing Omnis

- 1 Put the CD into the CD drive
- 2 Double Click on **My Computer** icon on the desktop
- 3 Double Click on **Smart2.04** icon in the window
- 4 Double Click on **OMNIS**
- 5 Double Click on **Win16, Win95 or Winnt** depending upon which Operating system you computer has. See above.
- 6 Double Click on **Setup###.exe** (again, as appropriate)
- 7 Click **Next**
- 8 Click **Next**
- 9 **IMPORTANT** - You must now change the install command line from  
`C:\Program Files\OMNIS Software Inc\OMNIS7371rt`  
to read **C:\Smart.**

## STEP 2

- 10 Click **Next**
- 11 Change the program folder to read **Smart.**
- 12 Click **Next**
- 13 A new window opens called **Smart.**
- 14 Click the close box to close the window.
- 15 Another window opens.
- 16 Select **No, I will restart my computer later.**
- 17 Click the **Close** button
- 18 Close the **WINNT** window (for Windows 2000 & NT)

## STEP 3

### Installing the Smart.net files

- 1 Click on the Windows **Start** menu
- 2 Select **Run.**
- 3 In the dialogue box enter **D:\Install.exe** (substitute the letter **D** with the letter of your CD drive if it differs).
- 4 A window **Smart.net Installer** will open.
- 5 Click on **Click here to continue.** This will install the remainder of software for SMART.net
- 6 Click on **Finish.**
- 7 The **Smart Installer** window opens.
- 8 Click **Close**
- 9 **Restart your computer** - before you launch the software

## STEP 4

### Later versions of Windows

- 1 If STEP 3 fails you will need to copy 3 files (Smartlib.lbr, Smart.df1, Omnispic.df1) from the CD into the C:\Smart folder.
- 2 You will need to make each of the 3 files read / write.
- 3 To do this right click on the new file and select 'Properties'
- 4 Uncheck the 'Read Only' box
- 5 Click 'OK'

## STEP 5

### Setting up a Shortcut to launch Smart.net

- 1 Launch **Windows Explorer.** Hold the Windows key on your keyboard and type an **E**  
The Windows Explorer window opens.
- 2 Click on the **+** symbol next to the **(C:)** drive icon

The Contents of **C** drive are displayed below

- 3 Click on the **Smart** folder icon  
The contents are displayed (to the right)
- 4 Right click on the file **Smartlib**
- 5 Select **Create Shortcut**
- 6 Drag and drop the newly created shortcut to the desktop. You can only see the desktop if the Explorer view is not expanded to full screen size.

## STEP 6

### Launch Smart.net

- 1 Double Click on the **Smart.net** shortcut.
- 2 The first time you do this you will need to enter serial number details. This can be found on the CD case.

Make sure the Smart network is correctly tested and connected to the PC **BEFORE** you launch the software.
